

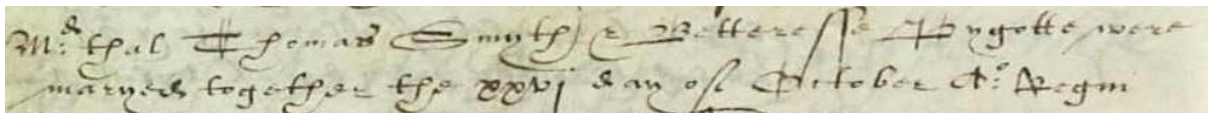


St Germain's Church

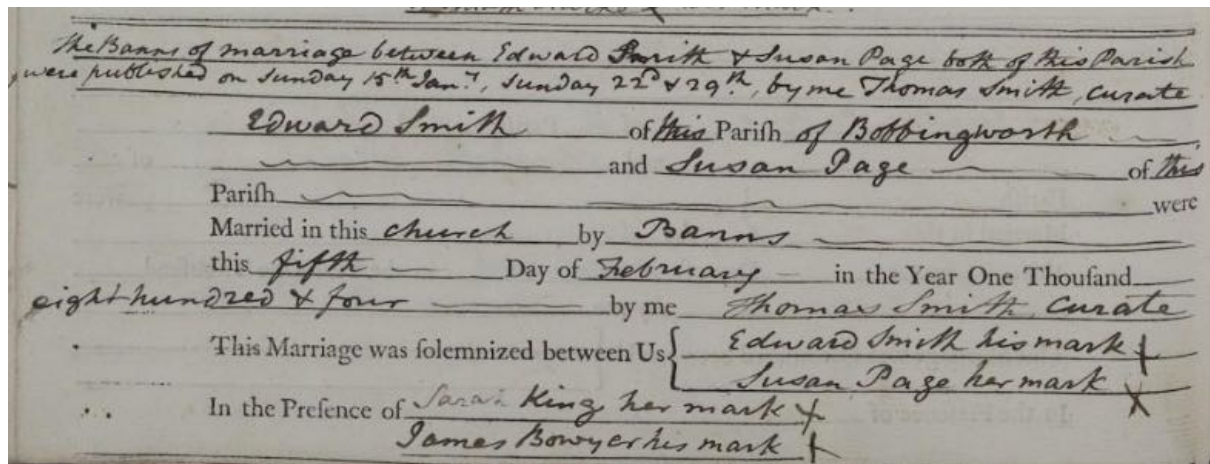
