Phyllis Smith wife of Mr Smith from London was buried on 3rd June 1730

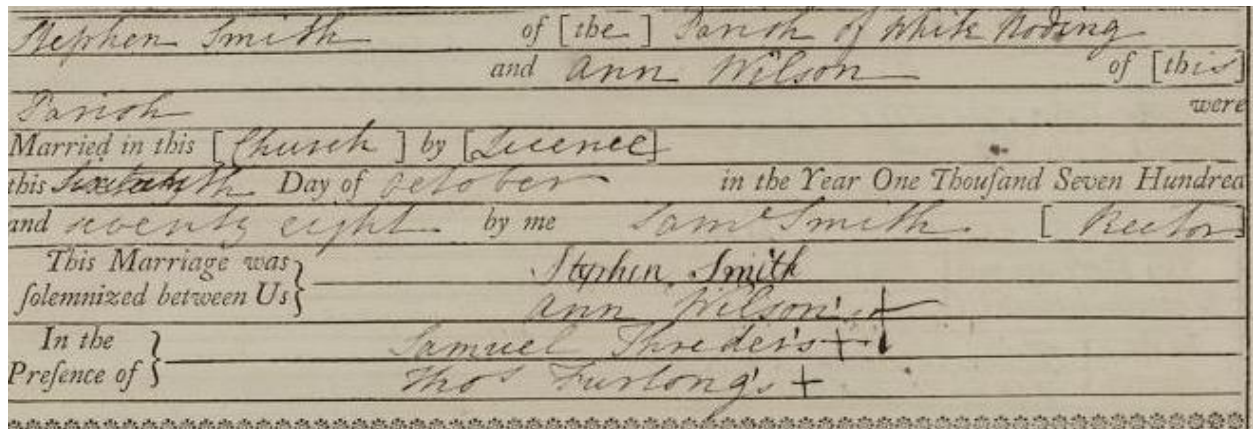
Richard Smith and Elizabeth Warman were married on 24th October 1731

The names of the witnesses are written in cursive.

Belinda Smith aged 24 wife of Sir GH Smith Bart was buried on 29th January 1825

Charles Joshua Smith aged 30 was buried on 22nd January 1831

Elizabeth Smith aged 89 was buried on 13th May 1832

Charles Doe and Elizabeth Smith were married on 13th October 1838

Dame Mary Smith aged 42 was buried on 9th July 1842

Edward Smith from Aldgate, London and Mary Anne Cooper were married on 14th May 1843

Mary Anne Smith aged 21 was buried on 7th June 1845

Augusta Smith aged 73 from Mapledurham, Oxfordshire was buried on 25th October 1845

Richard Joslin and Sarah Anne Smith were married on 21st March 1857

Laurence George Capel Cure and Augusta Elizabeth Smith were married on 13th October 1857

Laura Smith daughter of Charles Cunliffe and Agnes Frederica Smith was born 23rd November 1858 and was baptised on 23rd January 1859

Reginald Cunliffe Smith son of Charles Cunliffe and Agnes Frederica Smith was born 5th December 1863 and was baptised on 15th January 1864

George Smith aged 60 from the Workhouse at Stanford Rivers was buried on 8th November 1880

Charles Cunliffe Smith Bart aged 77 was buried on 4th August 1905

Frederika Mary Cunliffe Smith age d57 from Brighton, Sussex was buried on 31st March 1908

Agnes Frederika Smith aged 76 widow of Sir Charles Cunliffe Smith Bart was buried on 8th March 1913
